Brief Description:

1. Pursuant to past records, the operational statistics of major highways in Shenzhen region generally remained in a lower level during the Spring Festival month. The Spring Festival of 2009 was in January, while that of 2008 was in February. As such, the year-on-year changes in relevant statistics for this month recorded a sharp decrease, but remained stable as compared to the statistics of February 2008. The following statistics are for reference:

Contrary to the operational statistics of the above-mentioned highways, the operational statistics during the Spring Festival month of both Yangmao Expressway and Guangwu Project in the past two years were the highest throughout the respective year, so these highways recorded a significant growth this month as compared to the same period of last year.

- 2. Affected by the snow disaster in early 2008, the statistics for the same period of last year of Changsha Ring Road, Wuhuang Expressway and Nanjing Third Bridge were on the low side.
- 3. In January 2009, the negative impact on the traffic volumes and toll revenues on most of the Group's toll highways from the factors such as slowdowns in macro-economy growth still existed. Together with the effect of the Spring Festival vacation, the traffic volumes of carrier vehicle decreased obviously.
- 4. Pursuant to the requirements of relevant government authorities, the highways such as Jihe Expressway, Yangmao Expressway, Wuhuang Expressway and Nanjing Third Bridge continued to adopt "Green Passage Toll Free Policy" for carrier vehicles legally carrying fresh agricultural products in succession.
- 5. Main route of Nanguang Expressway opened to traffic for operation on 26 January 2008, and the statistics was not comparable. The road surface works for the reconstruction of Qinglian Project into an expressway was completed on 26 December 2008 and the road has resumed full opening to traffic. Qinglian Project was closed by section for construction works during the same period of 2008, and the statistics was not comparable.
